SUBJECT: Travel Restrictions

To protect our employees, citizens and patients from the potential spread of the COVID-19 virus, all non-essential travel is suspended effective immediately for the next two weeks. Requests for exemptions should be escalated to the appropriate cabinet member and submitted to Greg Anderson, Tribal Administrator, for review by the Office of the Principal Chief.

In addition, considerations should be given for hosting or attending large group gathering events in an effort to minimize exposure. Cabinet Members must decide if the event is necessary or required worth risking exposure to the employee and attendees. Should employees be exposed by entrance to an affected area or by someone, employees will be required to self-isolate for 14 days. An employee call line is currently being established for phone screenings.

MCN is staying abreast of all updates regarding COVID-19 as the CDC and health officials learn more about the virus and impact. MCN is continually monitoring the situation and will adapt our policies in accordance with CDC guidelines. Adjustments to our daily operations, including travel policies, will be communicated by cabinet members.
