General Summary:	Assist Professional Surveyor to perform all aspects of topographic, ALTA, boundary, and construction related surveying fieldwork: Provide data relevant to the shape, contour, gravitation, location, elevation, or dimension of land or land features on or near the earth's surface for engineering, mapmaking, mining, land evaluation, construction, and other purposes.
Principal Duties and Responsibilities:	Other duties may be assigned. Ability work independently, unsupervised, completing all tasks related mainly to survey field work; Verify accuracy of survey data including measurements and calculations conducted at survey sites; Calculate heights, depths, relative position, property lines and other characteristics of terrain; Prepare, maintain and keep detailed field notes; Ability to use theodolites, transits, levels, and satellite-based position systems (GPS), Total Station and Robot; Ability to locate utilities including verifying and noting depths, sizes and types; Ability to recognize needed procedures and suggest them to a supervisor for review.
Minimum Requirements:	To perform this job successfully, an individual must have knowledge of the principles, practice methods and techniques used in the civil engineering profession. Ability to recognize and trouble shoots when equipment is malfunctioning. Ability to perform all aspects of: topographic, ALTA, boundary, and construction related surveying fieldwork.
