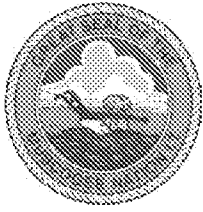

General Summary:	Under the supervision of the Housing Management Manager, the Insurance Specialist Assistant shall assist the Insurance Specialist to prepare documents, create work orders and follow through to completion of insurance claims, maintain inventory and filing system for two (2) insurance programs, and perform clerical work related to Insurance.
Principal Duties and Responsibilities:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Assist with maintaining current inventory of homes insured by the Dept. of Housing as well as adding and deleting from the insurance inventory in tenant accounts system when requested. 2. Update inventory of homes through the Amerind insurance portal as needed. 3. Create work orders to process and reconcile insurance claims and file records of transactions through to completion. 4. Travel out in the field to take pictures when a serious claim happens as well as to meet the Adjustor when a claim needs to be assessed. 5. Attend trainings and/or seminars inside and outside of the state. 6. Enter new Community Shield participants in the tenant accounts system and process billing statements for the Community Shield Program as renewals come due. 7. Reconcile Community Shield accounts to insure accuracy. 8. Mail notices to applicants regarding delinquencies and insurance policy changes; Address complaints regarding insurance claims when received. 9. Assist to ensure the program is in compliance with policy and procedures adopted by the Department of Housing and all federally imposed guidelines of the Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act (NAHASDA). 10. Assist one Counselor with terminations, violation, bad debt accounts. 11. Other duties as assigned.

Public Relations:

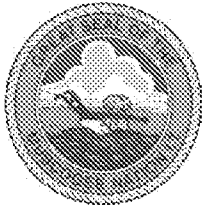

Each employee is expected to make every effort to be well-informed about the institution, pleasant, courteous and cooperative, and to act in a manner to command respect of co-workers and all other personnel. An optimistic attitude, patience and tolerance will help each employee in nearly all situations at the institution.

MCN Policy Requirements:

All Employees are subject to pre-employment background checks and drug testing. According to MCN Policy Section 502:Page 12/Section 503 110-111. All applicants must pass a drug test before beginning work. Any candidate who fails or refuses a drug test shall be withdrawn from employment consideration.

Medical Marijuana License Holder Protection and Non-Discrimination

A. Unless a failure to do would cause The Muscogee (Creek) Nation to imminently loose a monetary or licensing related benefit under federal law or regulations and with the exception of employees whose jobs are safety sensitive or primary job function is driving, The Muscogee (Creek) Nation shall not discriminate against a person in hiring, termination, or imposing any term or condition of employment or otherwise penalize a person based upon either: a. Solely, the person's status as a medical marijuana license holder; or b. Solely, the results of a drug test showing



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positive for marijuana and its components. B. Employees that are medical marijuana card holders shall not use, possess or be under the influence while at their place of employment or during hours of employment.
